

PRIMARY CARE PRACTITIONER (PCP) FORM

At Arise Health Plan, we believe that an effective partnership between patients and a primary care practitioner (PCP) is key.

This patient-centered approach provides members with a trusted health care partner who will manage their care and coordinate with other in-network physicians and specialists as necessary, with the goal of promoting better health at lower costs. That's why Arise Health Plan promotes healthy relationships between our members and a PCP.

Your PCP must be a participating practitioner and may practice in any of the following areas: internal medicine, family practice, general practice, pediatrics, or obstetrics/gynecology. Ideally, children should transition to adult-oriented health care between the ages of 18 and 21 years. For adolescents seeing a pediatrician, the transition will involve choosing a new physician, transferring medical records, and communicating treatment histories and insurance information. Children with chronic or ongoing illnesses also will need to transition their care from a pediatric subspecialist to an adult subspecialist.
